

## **Position:** Resident Service Coordinator (3yr. - Grant funded Position - FT- Family Services Department)

Serving as a liaison between the service providers and program participants, the coordinator will identify and coordinate public and private resources that will assist residents in becoming self-sufficient.

- Experience working with ethnically and culturally diverse populations and low income persons; and
- Knowledge of Tribal and non-Tribal programs and services that may be required to refer for services; and
- Technical skills of an intermediate to advanced user of MS Office software, computers, and office equipment.
- A valid driver's license and the ability to be insured under the Governmental policy.
