WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C.§ 1300k et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

Whereas, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, pursuant to Gaming Commission Ordinance # 04-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Tribe and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally-licensed gaming activities; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.04 (a) of the Gaming Commission Ordinance permits the Gaming Commission to promulgate regulations and internal operational procedures of the Gaming Commission and its staff; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council adopted the revised Commissions Ordinance #04-150-01 on January 9, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Section 6.01 of the Commissions Ordinance states that all Commissions shall have two creation documents – an Ordinance and by-laws; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.02 (f) of the Commissions Ordinance mandates that bylaws be reviewed on an annual basis by the Gaming Commission for amendments; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council adopted the revised Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04 on March 27, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission reviewed their by-laws and have made the revisions necessary to be compliant with Tribal law.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Gaming Commission hereby approves their revised by-laws; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the by-laws be forwarded to Tribal Council for placement on their agenda for approval.

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, pursuant to Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Triba and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally-licensed gaming activities; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.04 (a) of the Gaming Commission Ordinance permits the Gaming Commission to promulgate regulations and internal operational procedures of the Gaming Commission and its staff; and

WHEREAS, Gaming Commission Regulation #R400-04:GC-014 Chapter 14 - Hearings revisions were approved by the Gaming Commission on January 22, 2019 and most-recently a minor error in the Patron Complaint hearing process was identified causing the need for a revision.
