Approval of Payment of \$25,000.00 to the Little River Casino Resort for the Purchase of a Trane RTU 27 Roof Top Cooling Unit

WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C.§ 1300k et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04 which created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Tribe and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally licensed gaming activities; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the existing roof top cooling unit that services the Surveillance server and monitoring rooms needs a back-up unit to reduce the chances of a major catastrophe that would be detrimental to the gaming operation/Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Casino Resort has obtained a quote from Temperature Control, Inc. for the purchase of a 25-ton Trane RTU 27 roof top cooling unit (including roof repairs, crane service, duct system, electrical service to the unit, start up, and one (1) year warranty service) to serve as a back-up to the existing unit in the amount of \$50,800.00; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission has agreed to pay \$25,000.00 towards the purchase of the new Trane roof top cooling unit and the Surveillance Department Budget does include funds to cover the expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Appropriations Regulation #R100-01:AC-01 – Chapter 1 – Purchasing and Procurement designates actions of \$12,000.01 to \$25,000.00 require authorization from the Gaming Commission by resolution.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Gaming Commission hereby approves the expenditure in the amount of \$25,000.00 to the Little River Casino Resort from the approved 2018 Gaming Commission Surveillance Department Budget.

WHEREAS, Section 6.01 (d) of the Gaming Commission Ordinance gives the Gaming Commission the responsibility to conduct or cause to be conducted, investigations sufficient to make determinations as to the eligibility of persons and/or businesses applying for any license in accordance to Gaming Ordinance #10-400-01; and

Whereas, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(I) to take action, not inconsistent with the Constitution or Federal law, which is necessary and proper to carry out the sovereign powers of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Gaming Commission Ordinance # 04-400-04 which created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Tribe and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally licensed gaming activities; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission is, pursuant to Section 6.01 (d) of the Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04, to conduct or cause to be conducted, background investigations of persons or business entities applying for any license; and
