

APPROVAL OF CONTRACT FOR 2020 - 2021 WITH THE LAW OFFICE OF RICHARD G. MCGEE, LLC

WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C.§ 1300k et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7 (a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7 (I) to take action, not inconsistent with the Constitution or Federal law, which is necessary and proper to carry out the sovereign powers of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04 which created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Triba and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally licensed gaming activities; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission has a need for outside legal counsel to assist the Gaming Commission in drafting regulations, policies and procedures, and to represent the Gaming Commission with matters where there is a perception of a conflict of interest for the Unified Legal Department to provide the same legal assistance or if assistance is requested by the Gaming Commission after consulting with the Tribe's Unified Legal Department; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission believes it is imperative that they retain legal counsel experienced in Indian gaming regulatory matters and Human Resource matters and continues to be very satisfied with the services provided them by the Law Office of Richard G. McGee.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Gaming Commission approves the ceiling of billable fees for professional services in the amount of \$50,000.00 annually and expenses not to exceed \$5,000.00 annually; and

IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED THAT the contract will be forwarded to the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians requesting approval for execution.

PROHIBITING LITTLE RIVER CASINO RESORT FROM CONDUCTING BUSINESS WITH MIDAX, INC.

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C.§ 1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7 (a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7 (j) to take action, not inconsistent with the Constitution or Federal law, which is necessary and proper to carry out the sovereign powers of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has in Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Tribe and to enforce all Tribal, federal, and applicable state laws governing the conduct of gaming conducted on the Tribe's reservation; and
- WHEREAS, in Section 6.01 of Gaming Commission Ordinance, the Gaming Commission is authorized to enact and enforce such regulations consistent with the Gaming Commission Ordinance regarding its activities as the Commission may deem necessary and proper to effectuate the powers granted by the Ordinance and duties imposed by applicable law(s); and

- WHEREAS, Chapter 6 Section 3-1 of the Gaming Commission approved Regulations states that every person supplying any gaming service or concessions, gaming equipment, gaming devices or supplies to a gaming enterprise must obtain a Gaming Vendor License.; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 6 Section 3-2 of the Gaming Commission approved Regulations states that the gaming enterprise shall be responsible for notifying any person with which it is considering conducting business of the licensing requirements prior to contracting with such person; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 6 Section 3-3 of the Gaming Commission Regulations states that prior to the purchase of any gaming service or concession, gaming equipment, gaming device or supplies, the gaming enterprise shall forward a written "Notice of Intent to Conduct Business" to the Gaming Commission. The "Notice of Intent to Conduct Business" shall describe the services or concessions, gaming equipment, gaming device or supplies be provided by the vendor, together with a good faith estimate of the annual dollar amount of the projected purchases from the vendor. The gaming enterprise may not commit to any binding contracts or business transactions until the Gaming Commission has licensed the vendor; and
- WHEREAS, Midax, Inc. who is a licensed Gaming Vendor has not returned their renewal application associated with the renewal process; and therefore, the vendor's license will expire on August 21, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the Little River Casino Resort shall cease conducting business with Midax, Inc. effective August 21, 2019 and until such time that they are licensed as a Gaming Vendor.
