WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission By-Laws – Section 4.01 (a) requires the Gaming Commission to hold at least two (2) regular meetings per month and at such other times as may be deemed necessary to perform assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission's By-Laws – Section 4.0 (c) requires the Gaming Commission to establish a schedule for its regular meetings for each calendar year and requires amendments to the schedule be approved by resolution of the Gaming Commission and notice be posted in accordance to the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission approved its 2018 Meeting Schedule on November 14, 2017 and now finds it necessary to amend its meeting schedule by canceling its meeting on August 7, 2018.

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

Whereas, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, pursuant to Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Triba and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally-licensed gaming activities; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.04 (a) of the Gaming Commission Ordinance permits the Gaming Commission to promulgate regulations and internal operational procedures for the Gaming Commission and its staff; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission On-Call Compensation Policy was created to set forth the expectations of the Gaming Commission in the administration of Section 5.1 (Work Hours) of the Government Operations Personnel Manual; and

WHEREAS, this policy sets forth compensation (stipend and minimum allowance) and provide guidelines for those non-exempt employees who are required by management to be available to provide a specific essential/emergency function outside of their regularly scheduled work week.

^{*} Executive Assistant supports/assists the Executive Director in the vendor licensing process which includes (not inclusive) the following: initial contact with vendor (and control person(s) when applicable) explaining the application process and requirements; performs cursory review of application and attachments upon return to ensure completeness; initiates investigation; runs Dunn & Bradstreet Reports; conducts license verifications; processes personal reference checks, etc. Also prepares all renewal and initial licensing application letters and sends out licensing application packets; responsible for tracking vendor licensing information to ensure no vendor's license expires without the appropriate notification being sent to the vendor/licensee. Upon completion of all above, the entire file is provided to the Executive Director for review prior to placement on the Gaming Commission Meeting agenda for review and consideration.
