WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, pursuant to Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Triba and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally-licensed gaming activities; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission By-Laws – Section 4.01 (a) requires the Gaming Commission to hold at least two (2) regular meetings per month and at such other times as may be deemed necessary to perform assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission's By-Laws – Section 4.01 (c) requires the Gaming Commission to establish a schedule for its regular meetings for each calendar year by no later than the last regular meeting of the preceding year, that notice be posted in all Tribal government buildings, and that the schedule be forwarded to the department responsible for publication in the Tribal newsletter.

WHEREAS, Section 6.04 (a) of the Gaming Commission Ordinance permits the Gaming Commission to promulgate regulations and internal operational procedures of the Gaming Commission and its staff; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission Employee Licensing Procedure was last approved by the Gaming Commission on April 3, 2018 and a recent review revealed the need for revisions.

Upon completion of all above, the entire file is provided to the Executive Director for review prior to placement on the Gaming Commission Meeting agenda for review and consideration.
