GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM VENDOR LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR MMM MEAT, LLC D/B/A TOLMAN'S WHOLESALE MEATS

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C.§ 1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(I) to take action, not inconsistent with the Constitution or Federal law, which is necessary and proper to carry out the sovereign powers of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has in Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Tribe and to enforce all Tribal, federal, and applicable state laws governing the conduct of gaming conducted on the Tribe's reservation; and
- WHEREAS, in Section 6.04 of Gaming Commission Ordinance, the Gaming Commission is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the orderly performance of its duties and powers which shall include; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 19 Section 3-1 of the Gaming Commission approved regulations states that every person supplying any goods, services, and/or concessions to any gaming enterprise must obtain a Non-Gaming Vendor License unless exempt from licensing requirements pursuant to Section 3-4 or Section 3-5 or meeting the definition of Service Vendor; and

- WHEREAS, Chapter 19 Section 3-2 of the Gaming Commission approved regulations states that the gaming enterprise shall be responsible for notifying any person with which it is considering conducting business of the licensing requirements prior to contracting with such person; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 19 Section 3-3 of the Gaming Commission approved regulations states that prior to the purchase of any goods, services, and/or concessions the gaming enterprise shall forward a written "Notice of Intent to Conduct Business" to the Gaming Commission. The "Notice of Intent to Conduct Business" shall describe the goods, services, and/or concessions to be provided by the vendor, together with a good faith estimate of the annual dollar amount of the projected purchases from the vendor. The gaming enterprise may not commit to any binding contracts or business transactions until the vendor has been licensed by the Gaming Commission; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 19 Section 3-4 (b) of the Gaming Commission approved regulations states that the Gaming Commission may grant special exemptions from vendor licensing requirements for persons or businesses providing professional services or unique services. Persons or businesses that may qualify for special exemptions are those in the following categories: persons or businesses from which the gaming enterprise purchases advertising (billboard companies, trade magazines and newspapers); advertising agencies providing artistic or creative services; and persons or businesses making isolated (single item/event) sales or purchases of goods or services that do not impact gaming activity; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 19 Section 3-5 of the Gaming Commission approved regulations states that the gaming enterprise must submit a request for exemption from the licensing requirements, including documentation supporting the vendor is highly regulated or supporting documentation how the vendor qualifies for a special exemption. The gaming enterprise shall forward a written "Notice of Intent to Conduct Business" to the Gaming Commission. The "Notice of Intent to Conduct Business" shall describe the goods, services, and/or concessions to be provided by the vendor, together with a good faith estimate of the annual dollar amount of the projected purchases from the vendor; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 19 Section 3-6 of the Gaming Commission approved regulations states that the gaming enterprise is prohibited from entering into any contract until the vendor has been exempted by the Gaming Commission. Vendors granted an exemption by the Gaming Commission shall be required to provide a completed Conflict of Interest Disclosure in a form satisfactory to the Gaming Commission prior to the commencement of business with the gaming enterprise; and

WHEREAS, the gaming enterprise has requested exemption from the vendor licensing requirements for MMM Meat, LLC d/b/a Tolman's Wholesale Meats who is a food vendor and regulated or licensed by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA).

NOW THEREFORE IT IS THE ORDER of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Gaming Commission that MMM Meat, LLC d/b/a Tolman's Wholesale Meats shall be exempted from the licensing requirements for purposes of providing food related services for the Little River Casino Resort. This exemption is valid once the Gaming Commission is in receipt of the Conflict of Interest Disclosure form between the Little River Casino Resort and the vendor per Chapter 19 – Non-Gaming Vendor Licensing – Section 3-6.
