# Approval of Gaming Law and Regulation Training by Richard G. McGee in the Amount of \$4,850.00, plus Expenses

WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C.§ 1300k et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(I) to take action, not inconsistent with the Constitution or Federal law, which is necessary and proper to carry out the sovereign powers of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04 which created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Tribe and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally licensed gaming activities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Gaming Commission Ordinance #04-400-04 – Section 6.02 (g), the Gaming Commission shall arrange for training of Gaming Commissioners, Gaming Commission employees, and others; and

LRGC Resolution #GC18-0925-32 Approval of Gaming Law and Regulation Conference by Richard G. McGee in the Amount of \$4,850.00, plus Expenses Page Two

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Gaming Commission's By-Laws Article III – Section 3.01 (g), the Gaming Commission shall arrange for training of Gaming Commissioners, Gaming Commission employees, and others; and

WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission has negotiated a proposal to engage Richard G. McGee, to provide a gaming law and regulation conference on-site (Little River Casino Resort) on December 10-11, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the training will focus on concepts related to sovereignty, immunity, gaming laws, roles and relationships of gaming regulators as well as some elements related to the future of gaming; and

WHEREAS, this training is unique in the fact that it is designated training specifically for Gaming Commission roles and responsibilities.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Gaming Commission hereby authorizes Richard G. McGee to provide the Gaming Commissioners, staff, legal counsel, Tribal leaders and other gaming regulators training December 10, 2018 and December 11, 2018; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Gaming Commission approves payment to Richard G. McGee in the amount of \$4,850.00, plus expenses not to exceed \$2,500.00 from the Gaming Commission approved Administrative Budget.

Upon completion of all above, the entire file is provided to the Executive Director for review prior to placement on the Gaming Commission Meeting agenda for review and consideration.
