Position: Family Nurse Practitioner/Advanced Practice RN – Health Services Department
(Full Time Permanent)

Summary: Provides outpatient acute and/or routine primary medical care to a specified patient population under the general collaboration or supervision of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Clinic Physician. Abides by established protocols and accepted standards of practice.

Employment Qualifications: A qualified candidate offers:

- A current, active and unrestricted State of Michigan RN license.
- A Master's, Post-graduate, or Doctorate degree from an accredited FNP or APRN program recognized by the state of Michigan.
- Advanced Practice Certification by a national certifying body accepted by the state of Michigan.
- A minimum of 3 years' experience as a Nurse Practitioner, with experience in community health care and cultural diversity.
- BLS certification.
- A current DEA certification, or will obtain within 90 days of hire.
