B. Approving Letter of Support to the Sponsors in the United States Congress for the Native American Tourism and Improving Visitor Experience (NATIVE) Act

**Tribal Council** 

The NATIVE Act (HR 3477 & S 1579) increases coordination and collaboration between Federal Agency tourism efforts and Local Tribal Government. This Act would open up funding to improve visitor experience in Indian Country and require

agencies to include Tribes in Tourism Planning.
