### PURCHASE OF DEDICATED SERVER TO OPERATE TDR DEMOGRAPHICS 8.0 SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is conducting a Tribal Census and needs specialized software for tabulating the Census data, and


WHEREAS, This specialized software requires a dedicated server to provide support for this specialized software to operate within our Tribal Computer System, and

WHEREAS, The Tribe has set aside funding to purchase this Server in the Tribal Planning Budget


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that by this resolution the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes the purchase of specialized dedicated server to operate the TDR Demographics 8.0 software for the amount of \$5,960.00
