A. Resolution to Require the Tribal Court to Report all Tribal Court Convictions to Michigan's L.E.I.N.

The Michigan Law Enforcement Information Network is a statewide computerized information system that serves Michigan's Criminal Justice Agencies by maintaining a Filing System of accurate and timely documented information readily available to all Criminal Justice Agencies. Tribal Court wants to report convictions to ensure the safety of its Members and Community.

B. Approval of Victim Services Program using a modified Tribal Tribal Ogema Logo Seal for educational and awareness purposes

The LRBOI Victim Services Program wants to use this modified logo in creating all written material for their program including brochures, ads, invitations, letters, video, web and all other written visual material that is intended for the public.

C. Amending Housing Regulation Chapter 1-Eligibility Procedures J. Friedel for Tribal Rental Homes
