Approval of Grant Application Request to the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) H-B1 Rural Healthcare Grant Program to alleviate healthcare workforce shortages by creating sustainable Employment and Training Programs in Healthcare Occupations (including Behavioral and Mental Healthcare) serving rural populations**

**Tribal Ogema**

The DOL has release rural healthcare work force development funding with awards ranging from \$500,000 to \$2.5 million to use over a 4-year period. Funds can be used to hire and train Behavioral and Mental Healthcare Workers. There is no cost share (match) required.
