    - Approval to Submit an Application for EQIP Funds and Engineering Support from USDA-NRCS for the Custer Culvert Replacement

A culvert on the Custer Trust Parcels has collapsed preventing ease of crossing by vehicle and foot on the parcel. This funding will assist with engineering to replace the culvert to prevent future collapse and allow the stream to not cause scouring by realigning the culvert to match the stream channel, preventing future collapses, due to large storm events caused by climate change.
