The FY 2023 budget appropriated Members Assistance 1080-137-000-5204 at \$720,000; over 50% of the funds from that line item were distributed for Bereavement claims, and the Members Assistance program has seen an increase in access requests. There is an excess of funds in the Insurance line 5209, and the request for transfer leaves a balance sufficient to pay remaining expected obligations. Requesting a transfer of funds from 1080-137-000-5209 Insurance in the amount of \$120,000 to 1080-137-000-5204.

Add 3. Approval of Supplemental Appropriation 2023-__-**Tribal Ogema** Fourth QTR to fund members Assistance 1080-137-000-5204 in J. Steinberg the Amount of \$100,000.00. The FY 2023 appropriation to Members Assistance 1080-137-000-5204 at \$720,000; over 50% of the funds from that line item were distributed for Bereavement claims, and the program has seen an increase in access requests. There are just over \$26,000 in outstanding obligations for client services, and requests continue to come into the department for assistance in all categories. This supplemental appropriation should allow for client benefit access through the end of the quarter (November/December).
