



**Summary:** This seasonal position will assist aquatic biologists and environmental specialists with monitoring of wetlands, wild rice beds, water quality, air quality and brownfield work on the reservation and in the 1836 Ceded Territories. This position will also assist other Environmental Division Staff on projects including open dump surveys, property assessments and air quality monitoring activities. This position includes extensive fieldwork as well as some data management duties. It requires flexibility in scheduling which may include late nights and weekends.

- Enrollment in a BS degree program in Biology, Aquatic Biology, Environmental Sciences or a closely related field; and
- A basic knowledge of wetlands, water quality; or basic knowledge of air quality; or basic knowledge of brownfield assessments/cleanups; and
- Ability to perform field work under strenuous conditions during all weather conditions; and
- Ability to work early morning, late night hours and weekends as dictated by assessment needs; and
- Basic computer skills with Microsoft Office including word, excel, and outlook; and
- Strong verbal communication, and teamwork skills; and
- Ability to maintain high confidentiality; and
- Superior performance in the selection process as determined at the sole discretion of the LRBOI Hiring Manager, including but not limited to all of the following: any pre-employment interviews, skills testing, credentialing, drug screening, background investigations, reference checks and previous work history, passing a pre-employment drug test and background investigation, possession of a valid Driver's License throughout employment and being insurable under the Tribe's insurance policy.

Conditions of employment with Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Government includes superior performance in the selection process, including but not limited to all of the following: any pre-employment interviews, skills testing, credentialing, drug screening, background investigations, reference checks and

previous work history, passing a pre-employment drug test and background investigation, possession of a valid Driver's License throughout employment and being insurable under the Tribe's insurance policy, and successfully completing a ninety (90) day introductory period.
